Important Information

Limits On Contributions

The Federal Government imposes limits on the amounts that a person can contribute to superannuation in any twelve month period. The information below relates to "non-concessional" contributions, which are generally contributions made from a member's after tax income.

From 1 July 2021, the non-concessional contributions cap is \$110,000. This is reviewed annually to remain in line with average weekly ordinary time earnings (AWOTE).

If you make contributions above the annual non-concessional contributions cap you may be eligible to automatically access future year caps. This is known as the bring-forward arrangement. It allows you to make extra non-concessional contributions without having to pay extra tax, if you meet certain eligibility conditions.

If your total super balance is equal to or more than the general transfer balance cap (\$1.7 million from 2021–22, \$1.9 million from 2023–24) at the end of the previous financial year, your non-concessional contributions cap is nil (\$0) for the current financial year.

Tax on Excess Contributions

Australian Food Super, like every other superannuation fund, must report all contributions it received and credited to your account to the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) after the end of each financial year. If you exceed your non-concessional contributions cap the ATO will send you a determination explaining your options. Usually you will be able to choose to either:

- 1) release the excess from your super funds; or
- 2) not release the excess amount from your super and pay the excess non-concessional contributions tax yourself

The ATO will issue Australian Food Super with an authority to release funds depending on the option you have chosen.
